

Equine First Aid Kits

Veterinarian's contact numbers

Multi-purpose fencing tool

(Can use to cut wire and pull nails or shoes if needed.)

Pocket knife

Duct tape

Vet Wrap or Co-Flex

Epsom salts

Gauze pads

Digital thermometer

Stethoscope

Antibiotic ointment

Antiseptic (Betadine solution, Chlorhexidine, Nolvasan)

Phenylbutazone (Bute) paste

Mineral oil and 20cc+ syringe

(Can orally dose the horse in the event of colic and it will be awhile for vet to arrive).

Epinephrine

12cc syringes

(Can use to administer medications or clean wounds)

Watch with a second-hand or a digital version that can measure seconds

(Make sure to check & replace batteries periodically)

Banamine (Check with your veterinarian, only available with a prescription.)

Sedative (Check with your veterinarian, only available with a prescription.)
